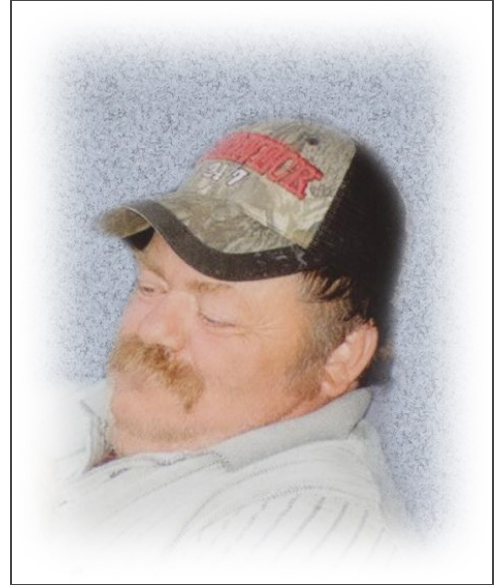


# Daryl Clifford Aarsby
