

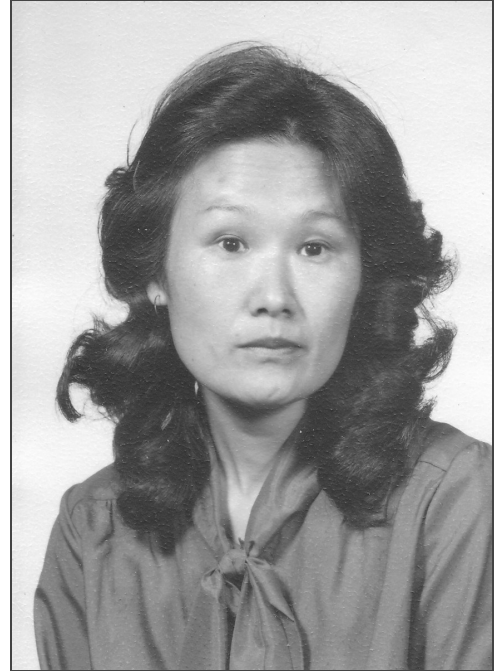
Atsuko Aasland
