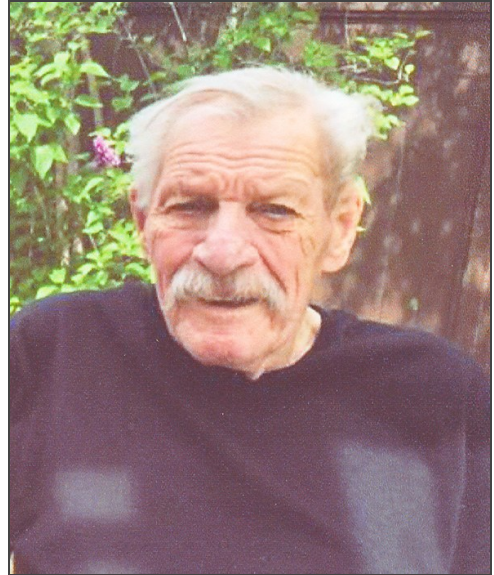


Henry (Hank) Adrian
