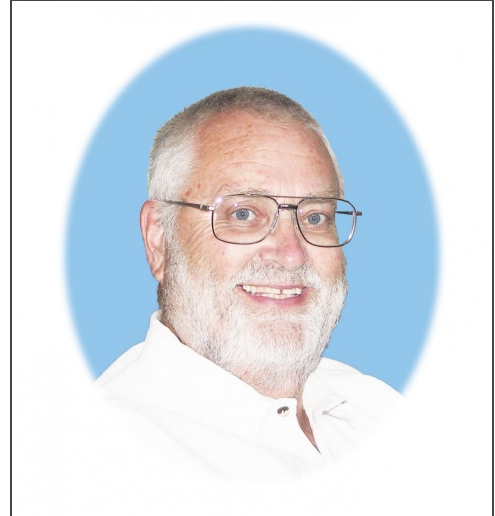


# Albert Alberda
