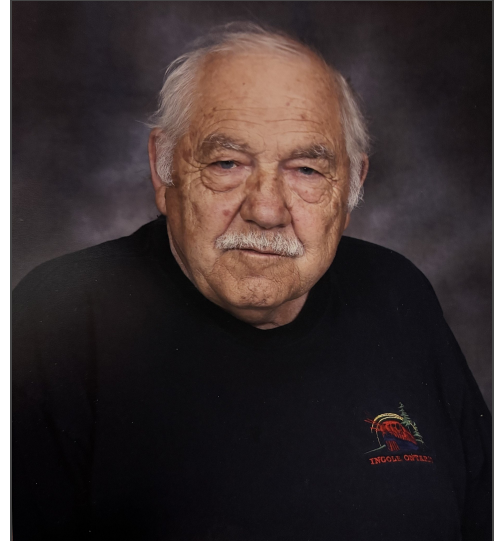
It is with heavy hearts that the family announces the passing of Allan Fredrick Ernest Earis, on May 20th, 2026, at the age of 87.
