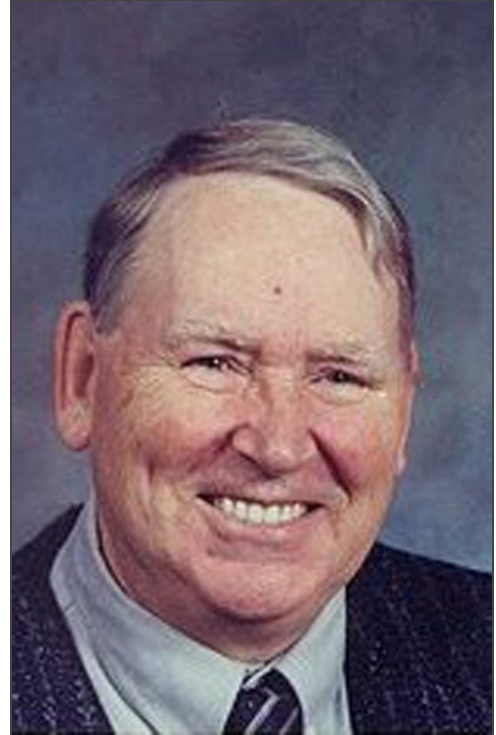


Mervin James Andrews
