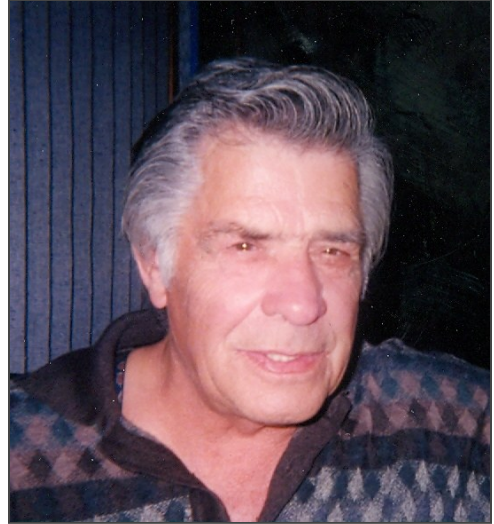


Clifford Raymond Anger
