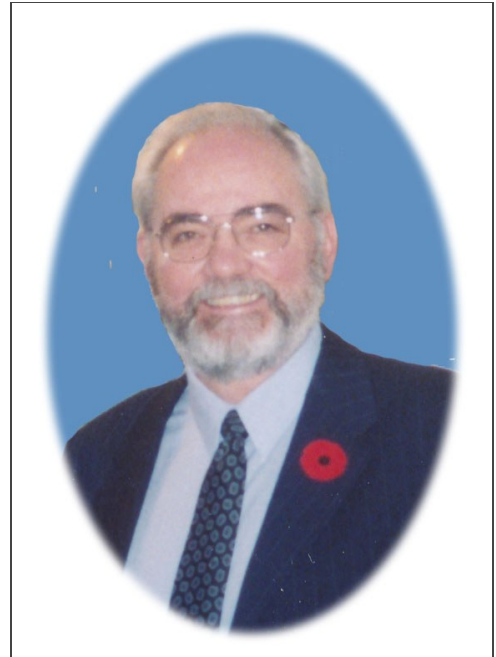


Lorne William Anthony
