

Gordon Wayne Aufner

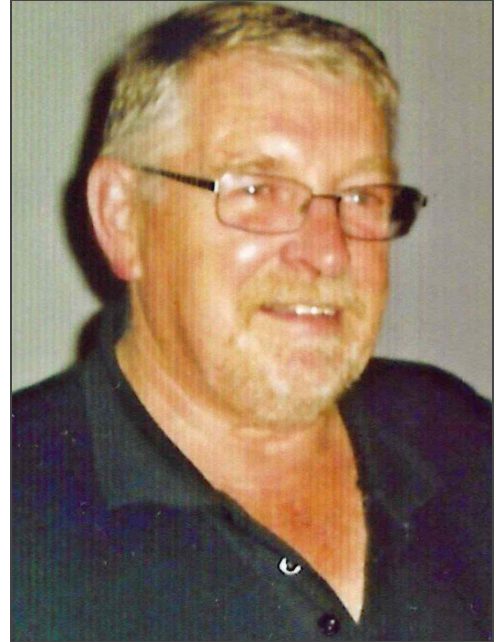
