

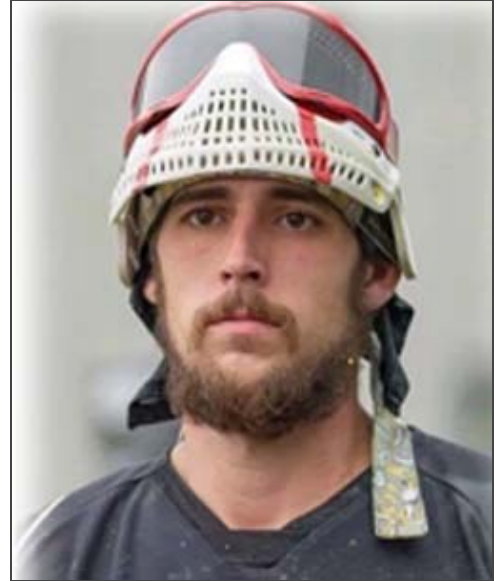
Adrian Theadore Bader
