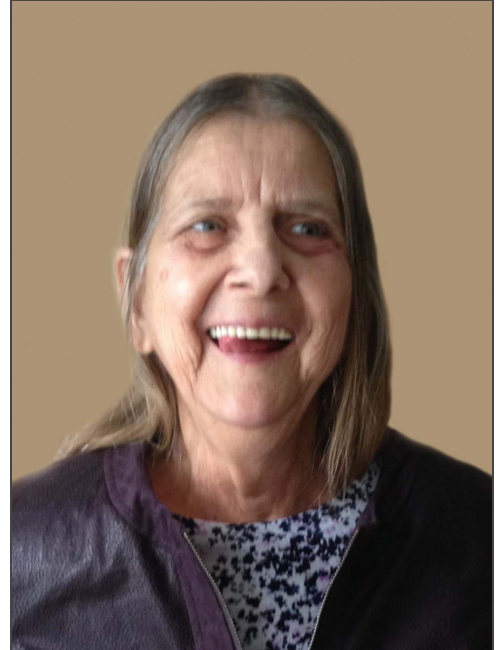


Adeline Bailey
