

Lindsay Emma Bailey

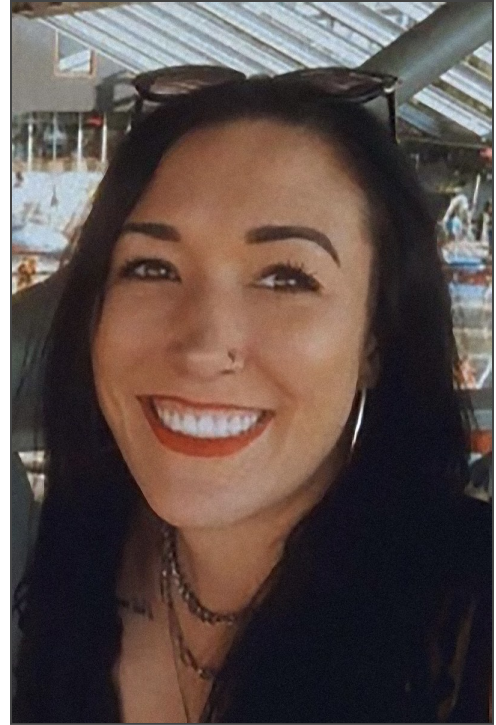
