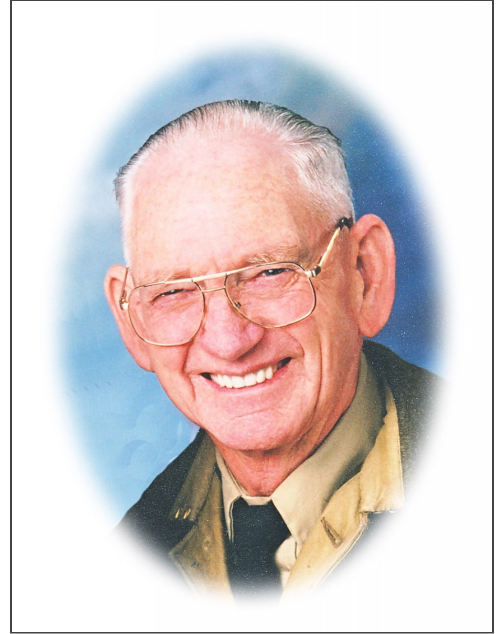
BAKER, Arthur (Art)
