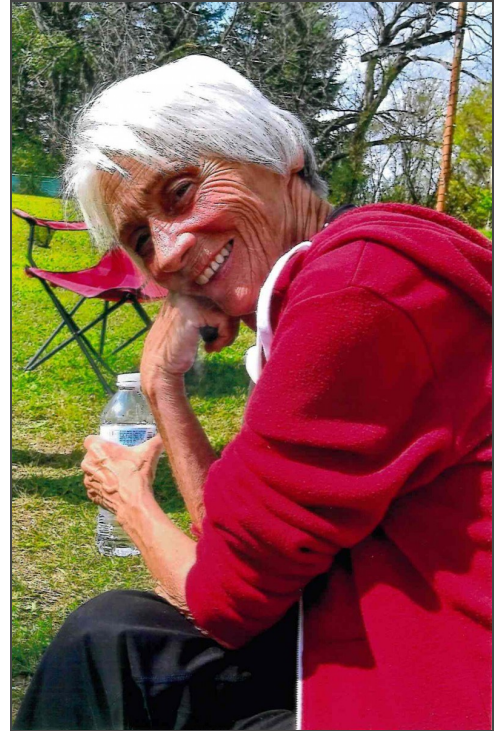


# Charmaine Judy Baker (nee Mang)
