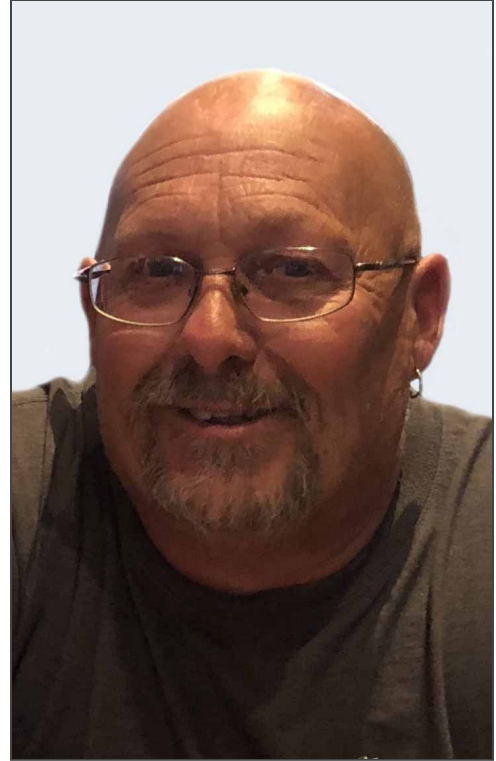


# Laurie Raymond Baldock
