It is with great sadness, the family announces the passing of Ron Barnes on September 16th, 2016.

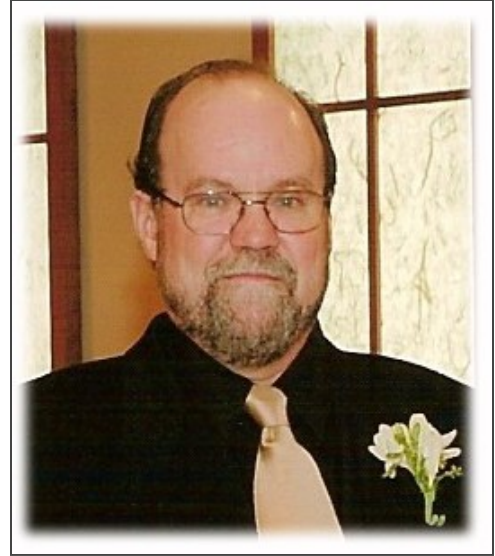
