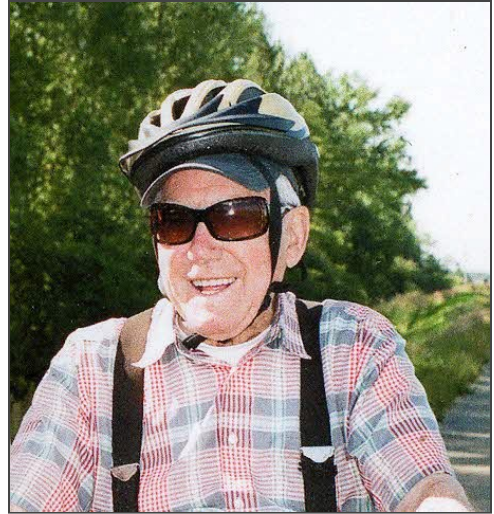


Lloyd William Barrett
