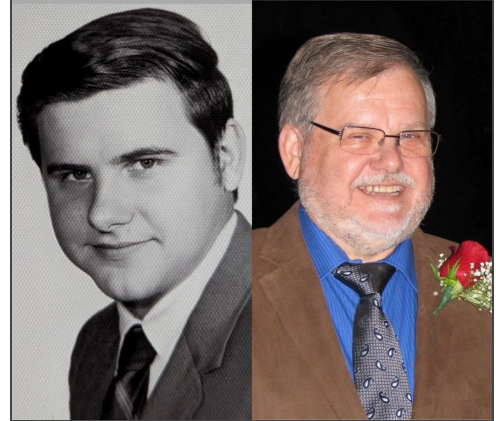


# Monte Noel Barrett
