The eldest of six brothers and sisters.

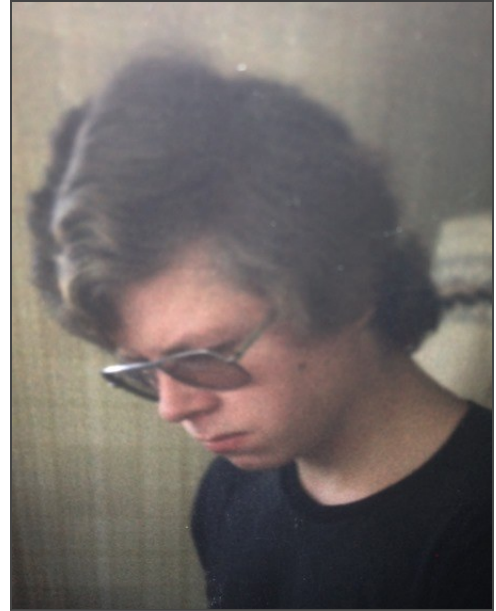
