

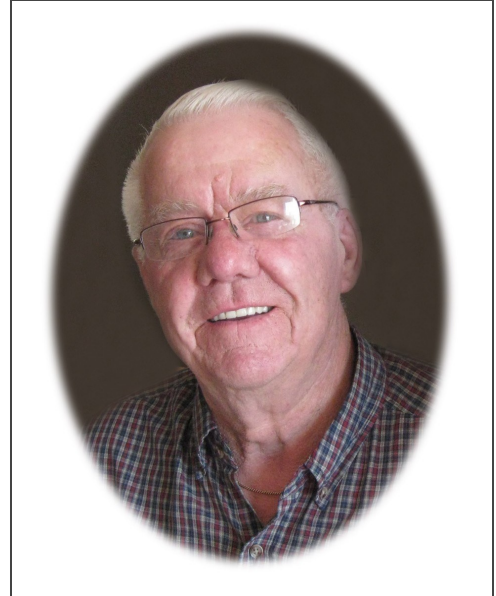
Clifford "Cliff" Webster Beatty
