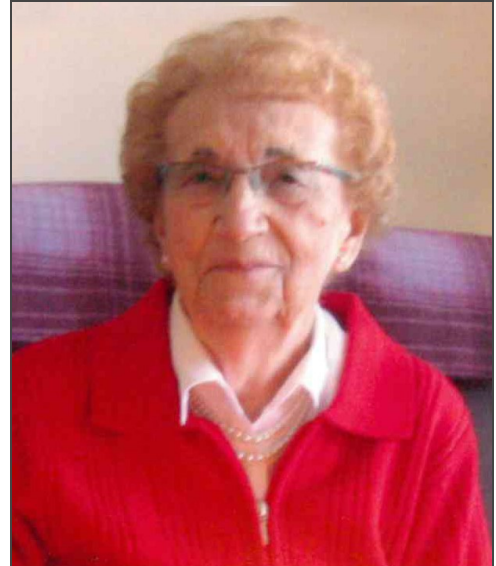


Christina Belles
