Mark was born in 1969 in Birmingham, England and on November 18, 2013 Mark's tragic and sudden passing has left us with heavy hearts.

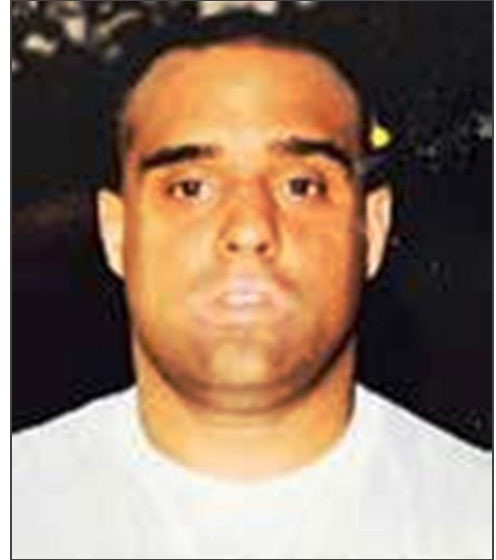
Mark is survived by his father, Lenford Berry (Christina) and his mother, Glenda Finck
