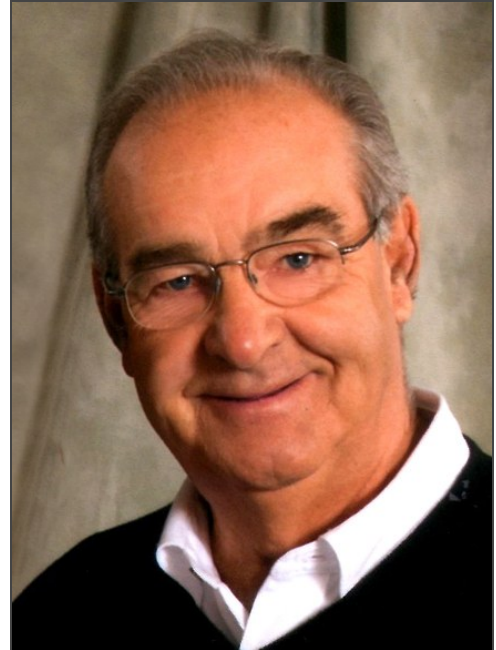


# Glen Birnie
