Close your eyes and I`ll kiss you

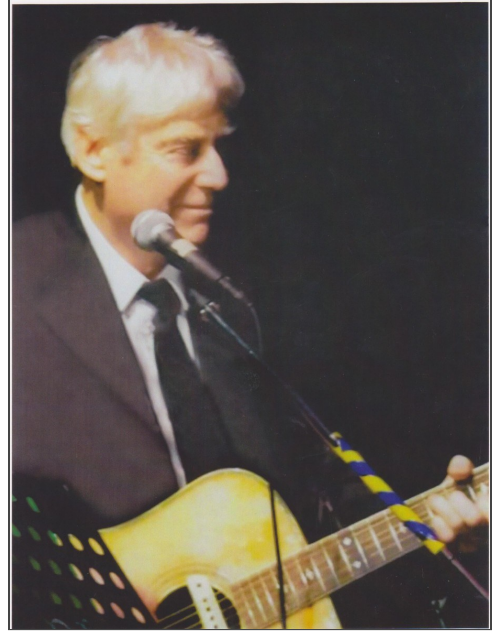
Tomorrow I`ll miss you
