

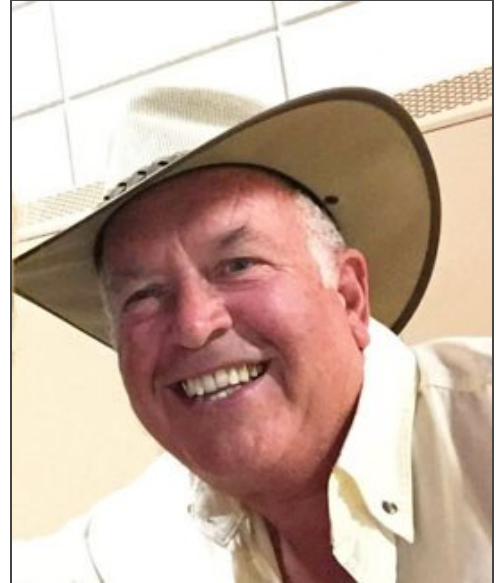
Murry John Blackmore
