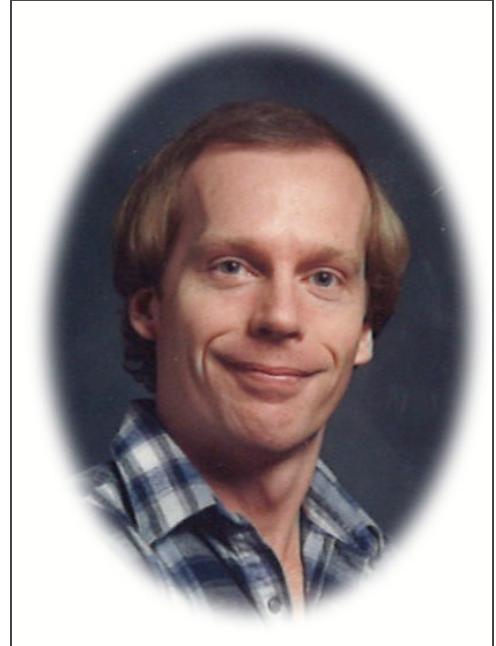


F. John Blair
