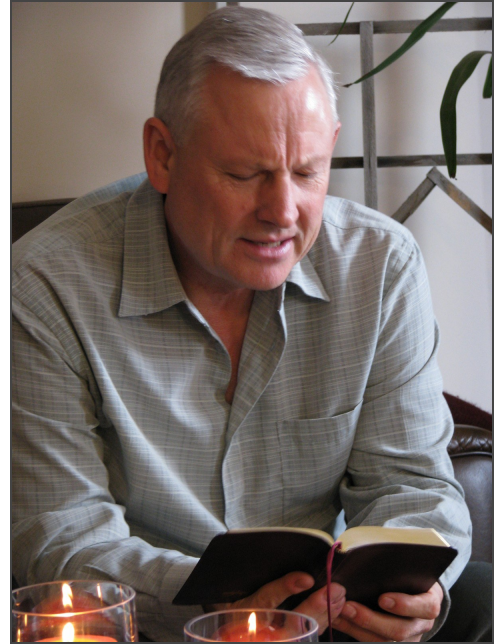


# Stanley Brian Block
