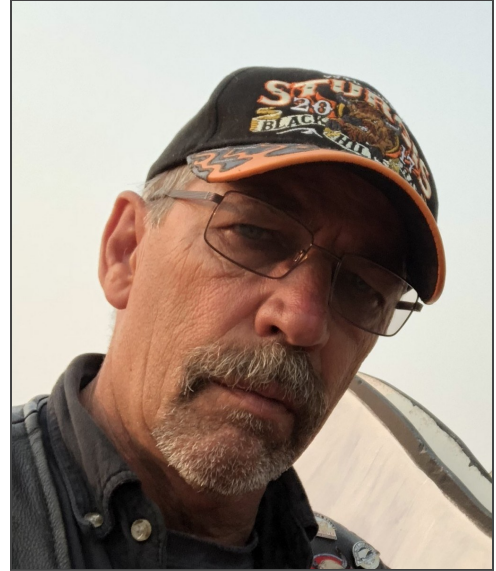


# Malcolm Floyd Bloos
