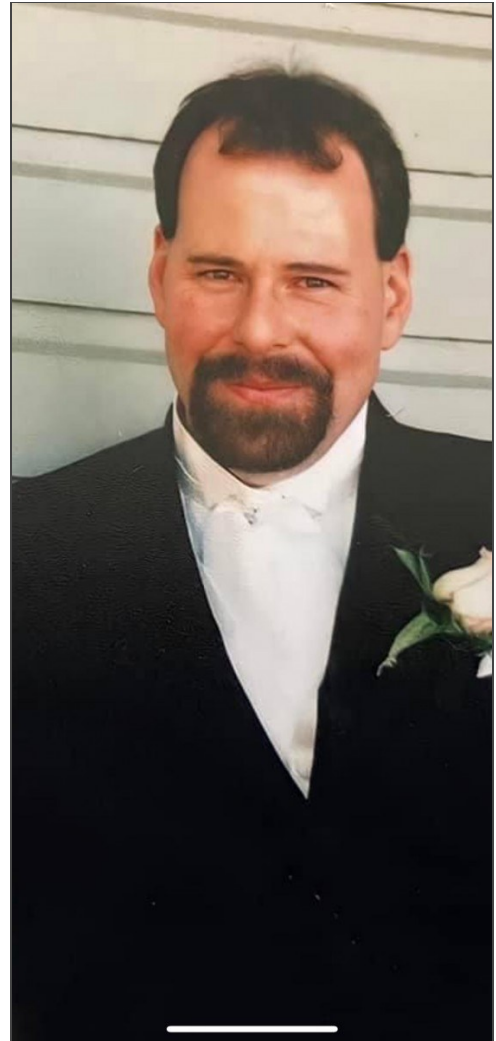
September 14, 1966 - March 5, 2022
