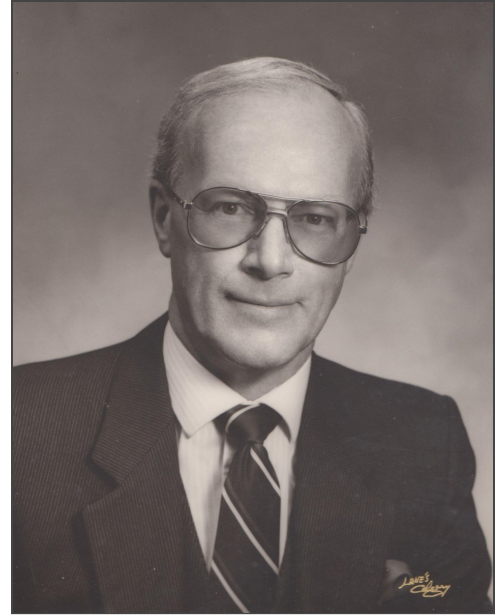


Leo Bowes
