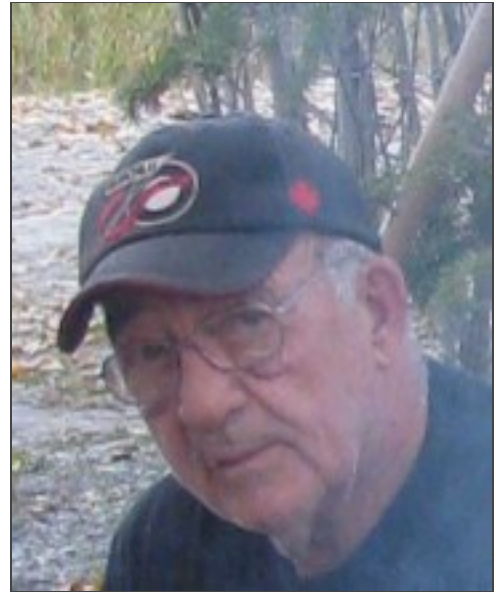


Ivan Charles Boyartchuk
