We are deeply saddened by the loss of our beloved Megan, who passed away suddenly on Friday, December 13, 2019.

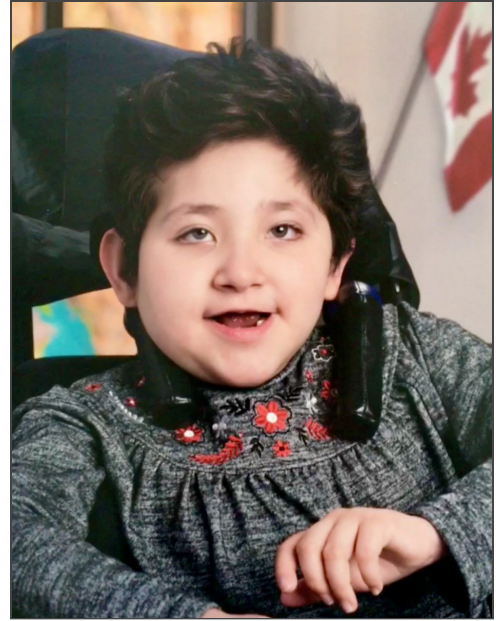
