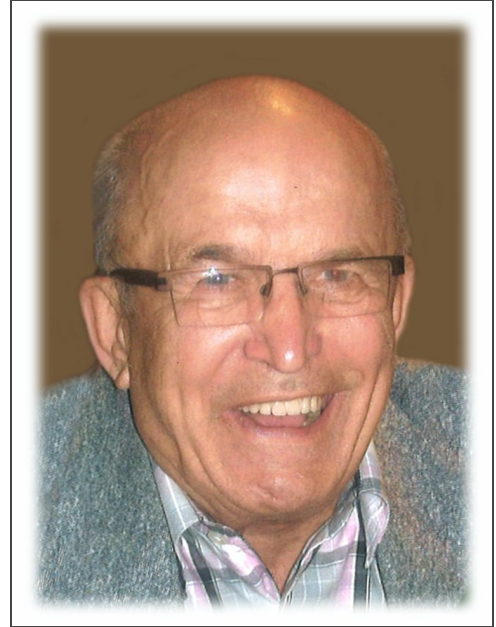


Adolph Joseph Braden
