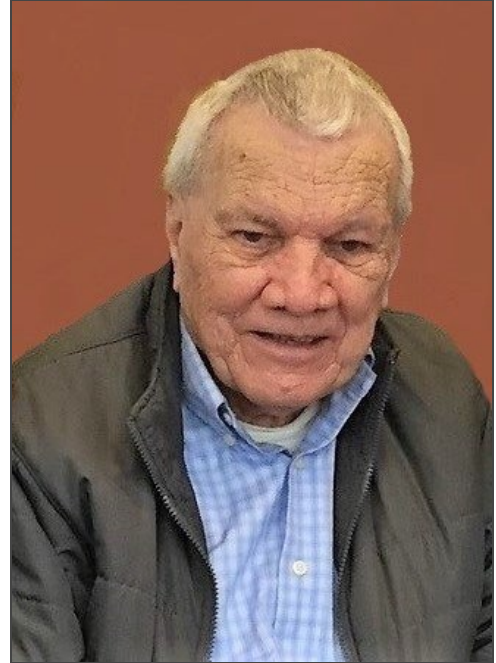


Robert (Bob) Norman Bray
