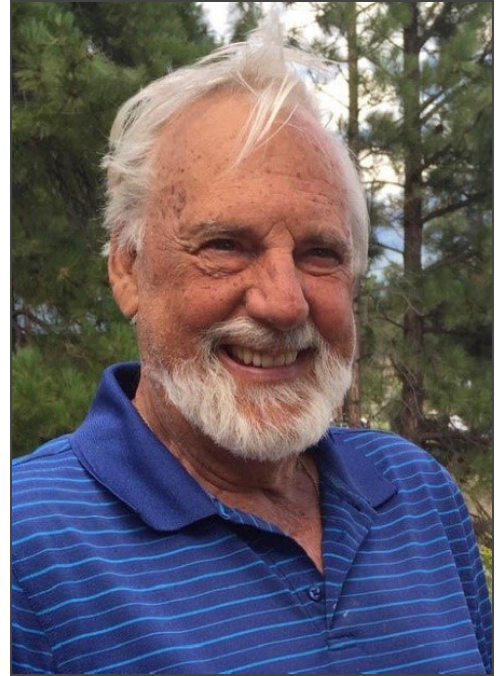


Derek M Bridges
