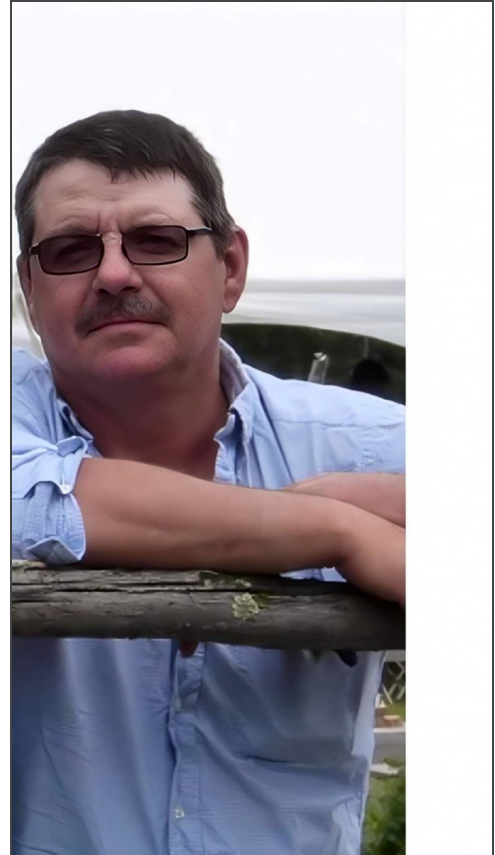


Joseph Dean Brown
