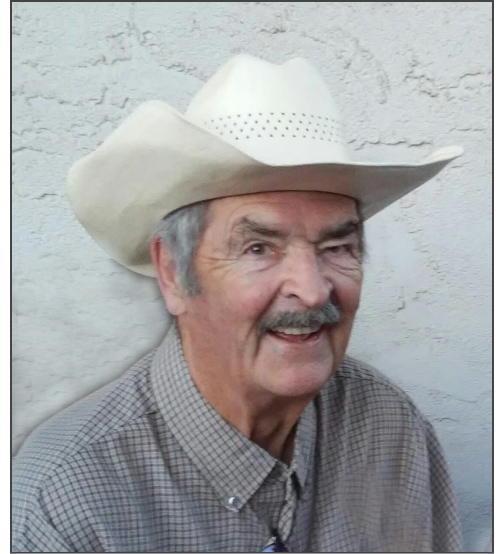


Phillip Royce Brown
