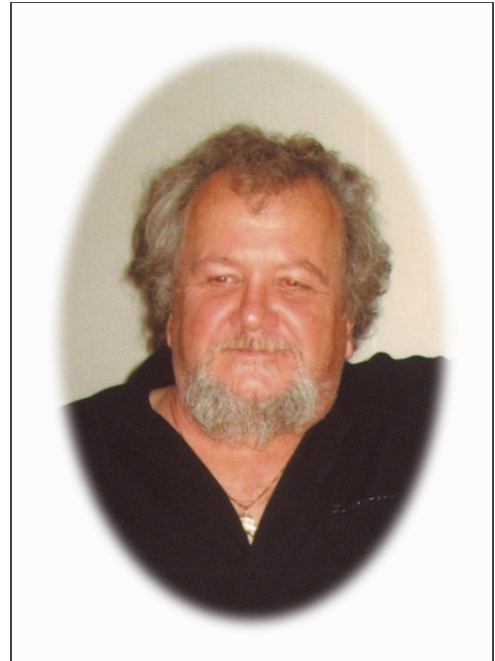


W. Graham (Curly) Brunette
