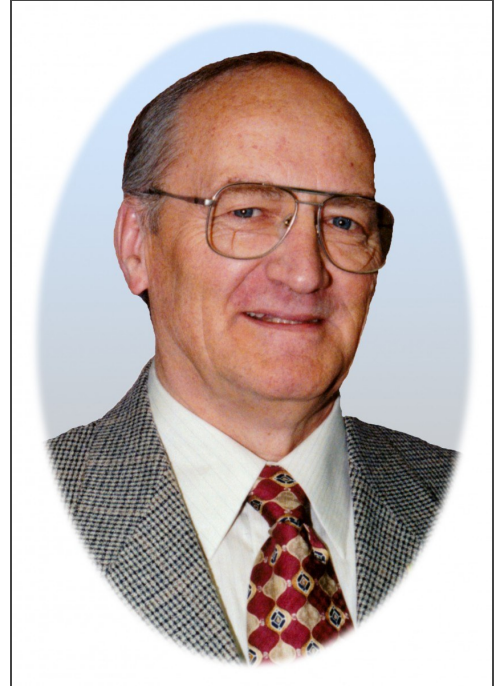


Edward Andrew Budzak
