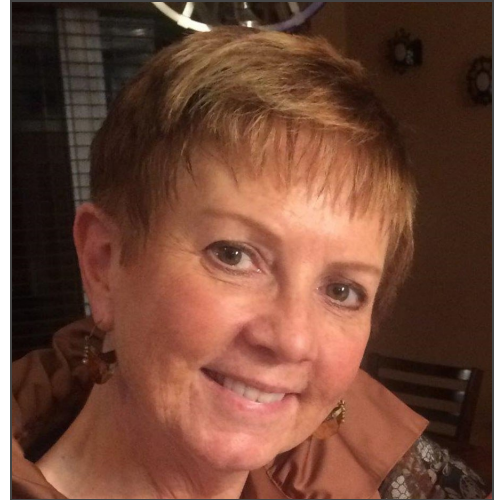


Maureen Leslie Buhr
