It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of our Mom Maria. Mom passed away peacefully at Silver Heights Special Care Home, Raymore, SK on July 23, 2021 with family by her side.

In later years as Dad's health began to fail,

Mom devoted herself to caring for him. In 2014 they moved to Regina, SK where she continued to look after Dad with help from family. Sadly, Mom's health began to fail as well, and it was no longer possible for them to remain in their home. They moved to Raymore and resided at the Silver Heights Special Care Home with the wonderful staff there looking after them.
