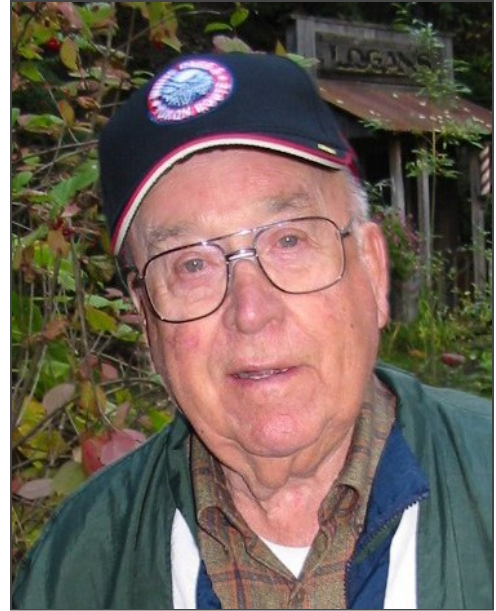


George Bull
