

Charisse Butler

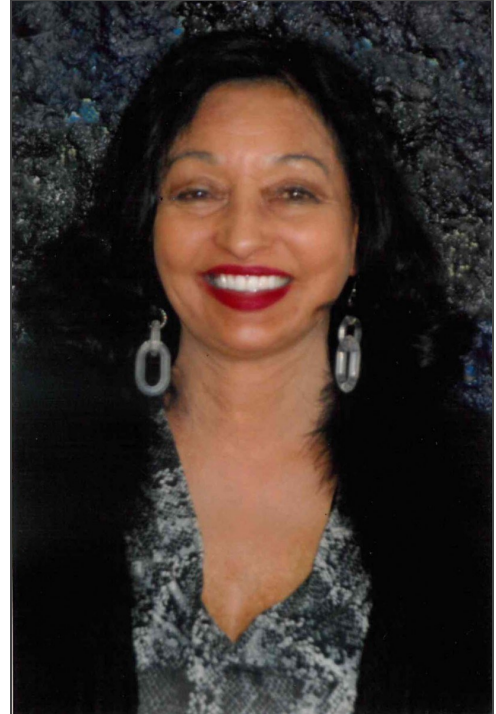
