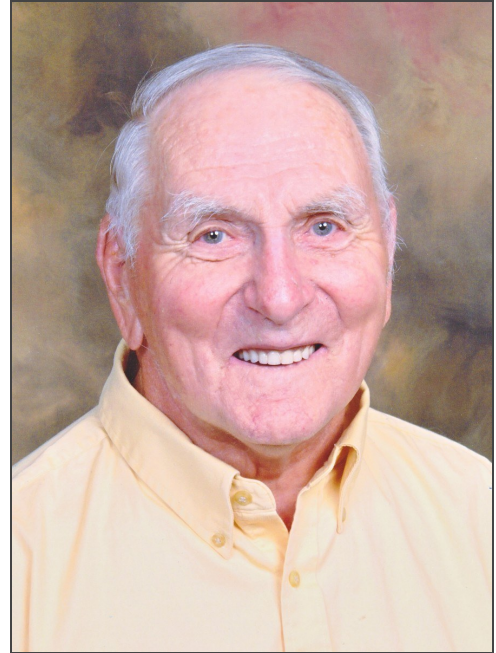


Gordon Eric Carlson

When the yard and outdoor chores became too much our Neighbors Brian and Kerry just took over and lifted that burden, Gordon hated not being able to do for himself but thanked God daily for these wonderful and neighbors and Grandson Dexton who seem to be on speed dial for many reasons.

Gordon leaves behind Joy and their two grown children, Blair (Leslie) children Dylan and Deanna, Julie (Cal) children Derek , Chelsea and Aaron
He was happy to welcome four Great grand children into his life.
