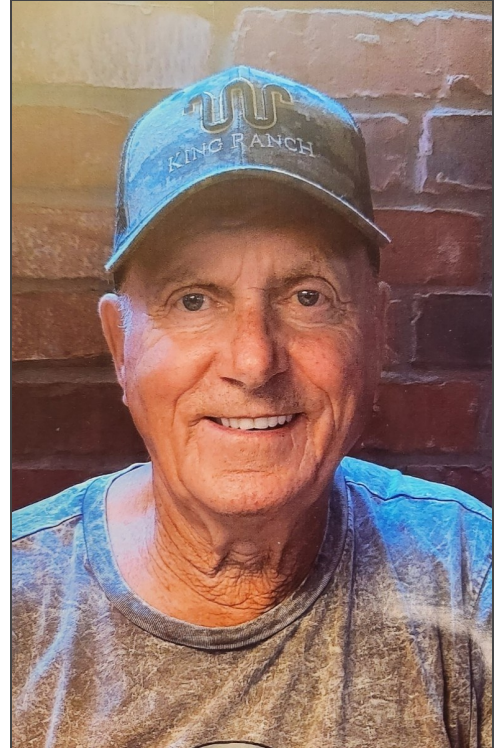
Dalhas Carpentier
