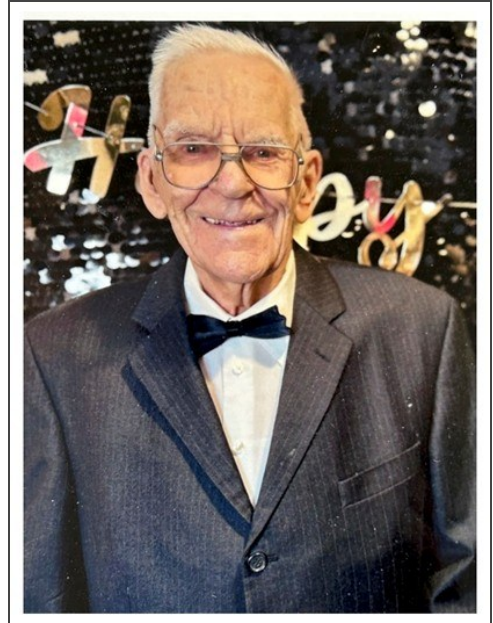
Hutchinson and was raised in Port Moody. He was predeceased by his parents and sister, Jacqueline Larsen also first wife Doreen.
