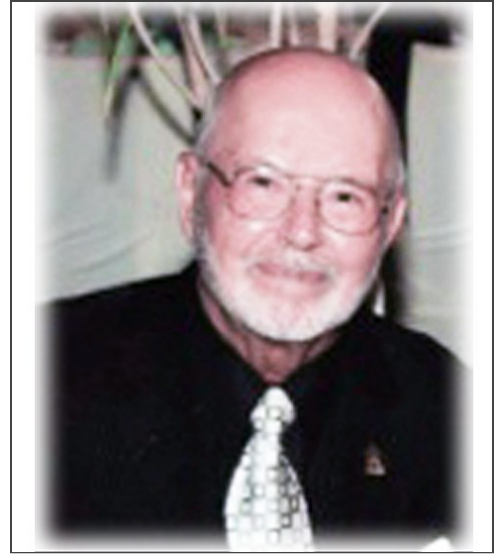


Hans Evald Christensen
