

Winston Harold Church

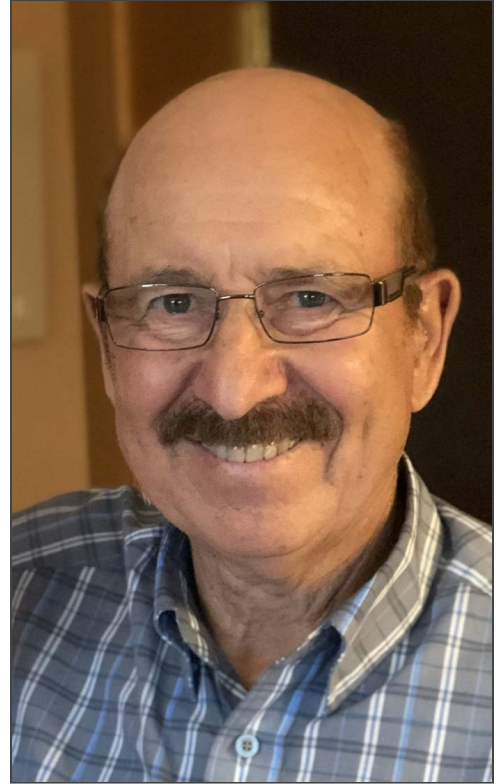
DECEMBER 4, 2022
