Softly and tenderly Jesus called Alan home on Wednesday, September 15, 2021.

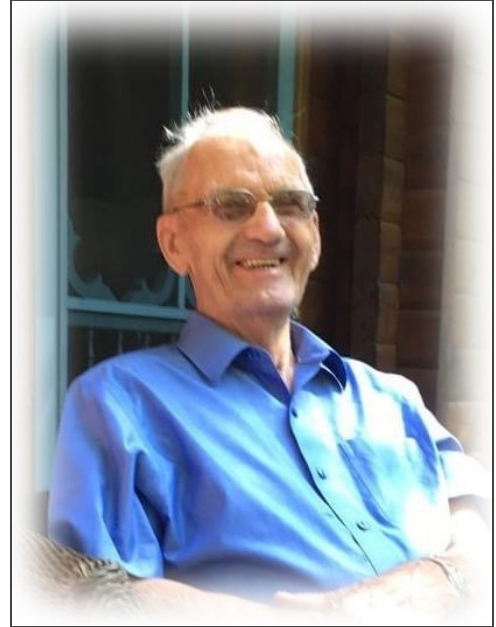
