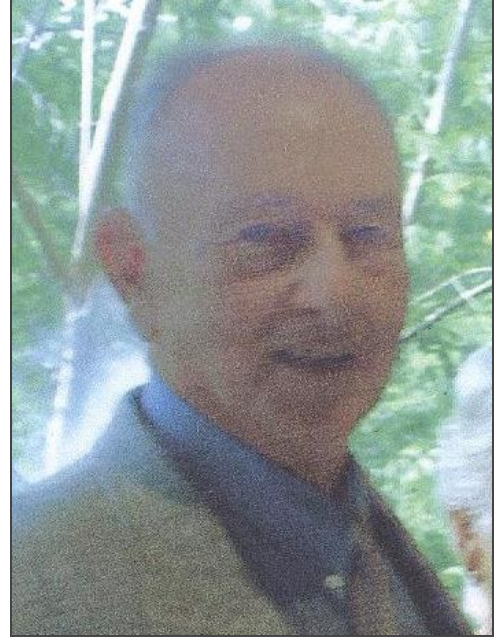


Warren Robert Clark
